- Synopsis** : In 2017's Chief Executive Policy Address, the Government initiated Modular integrated construction (MiC) method to improved productivity, safety, less demand for on-site labor and cost effectiveness. MiC refers to a method which free-standing volumetric modules (with finishes, fixtures, fittings, etc) are manufactured off-site and then transported for construction buildings.
- The Buildings Department had issued a practice note with pre-submission enquiry, pre-acceptance checklist and detailed guidelines for design and quality supervision requirements.
- “Wong Chuk Heng student hostel of the University of Hong Kong” was selected as one pivotal project by Development Bureau to implement the MiC. The speakers are the project-in-charge of this HKU campus development project will share the planning, construction management and views on adopting of MiC in high rise construction in HK commonly with congested site environment. Sharing on views from the practicing construction professionals of HKICM and supporting organisations.

: Speaker: Ir Prof K.L. TAM

Prof Tam is currently the Director of Estates and the Adjunct Professor in Faculty of Engineering at the University of Hong Kong. He is the Honorary President of the Hong Kong Institute of Construction Managers and a Registered Professional Engineer with over 38 years' experiences in project planning and construction management.

Served for about 28 years in HKU, Ir Prof Tam has been in charge of a variety of important and challenging projects for the university campus. These include the Medical Complex development at Sasson Road and Centennial Campus project. Stage 1 of Centennial Campus project involves the re-provision of service reservoirs that were relocated successfully in mad-made caverns; it has been selected as one of the 10 Hong Kong People Engineering Wonders in the 21st century by the Hong Kong Institution of Engineers and setting an unprecedented case in Hong Kong.

Ir Prof Tam has been active in the community services related to the industry and served in various advisory boards.

Speaker: Dr Louis Y.L. CHU

Dr Chu joined the University of Hong Kong since 2009 and he is currently the Assistant Director of Estates Office. He obtained his Ph.D. degree from the Hong Kong Polytechnic University on evaluation of performance of reinforced concrete cantilevered structures and he is the member of the Hong Kong Institute of Construction Managers.

Over the course of his professional career in the Construction Industry for more than 20 years, Dr Chu participated in various scales and complexities of construction projects in Hong Kong and Macau. These include commercial complex, residential buildings, all-suite hotel with 3,000 rooms, large scale site formation and foundation works, etc. He was an Asst Project Manger when he worked for the University in the past nine years. Major projects involved are the re-provision of services reservoirs, Centennial Campus and new 400-seat Auditorium. He is currently the project in-charge for Student Hostel projects and the new academic building for the Faculty of Medicine at Sassoon Road.
