Highlights of Seminar

Hong Kong is unique in the field of building development for its predominantly high-rise and high density. The control of planning, design and construction of private buildings and associated works is under the Buildings Ordinance and its subsidiary Regulations. At the same time, the legal system also makes provisions for the rendering safe of dangerous buildings and lands. This seminar will give an introduction of the principles, standards and outlines of the building control system adopted in Hong Kong.

Biography of Guest Speaker

Ir Prof. K.K. Choy is a Chartered Civil and Structural Engineer (CEng), a Fellow of the Institution of Structural Engineers (FIStructE) and The Hong Kong Institution of Engineers (FHKIE), a Registered Structural Engineer (RSE) under the Buildings Ordinance and a Class 1 Registered Structural Engineer (Class I RSE) of the People's Republic of China. He has been appointed as an Adjunct Professor of The University of Hong Kong and The Hong Kong Polytechnic University since 2004.

Ir Prof. Choy graduated from the Hong Kong Polytechnic in 1975 with an Associateship in Structural Engineering. He has gained over 40 years of working experience in the building industry. He retired from the Hong Kong SAR Government in 2011. Before then he was an Assistant Director of the Buildings Department, responsible for setting and reviewing policies and strategies on building control in respect of structural engineering design, construction and demolition of private buildings.

After retirement from the Government, he has joined Meinhardt (C&S) Ltd as a Director – Structural since September 2013.
