## **COOPERATION AGREEMENT**



This Agreement is made the tenth day of April, 2015 between the following parties:

# (a) Hong Kong Institute of Project Management

Whose registered office is situated at 11/F, AXA Centre, 151 Gloucester Road, Wanchai, Hong Kong

and

# (b) Society of Project Managers, Singapore

Whose registered office is situated at 70 Bendemeer Road, #03-01 Luzerne, Singapore 339940.

#### 1. Recitals:

- 1.1 The objectives of the Hong Kong Institute of Project Management are to develop, promote, and to enhance the development of project management in Hong Kong while providing support and professional knowledge enrichment for project managers.
- 1.2 The objectives of the Society of Project Managers, Singapore are to promote and develop the Project Management profession, as well as to advance and propagate sound managerial, technical and commercial practices and knowledge to Project Managers.
- 1.3 Both parties wish to work together to progress the professionalism of project management in Hong Kong and Singapore and provide beneficial opportunities to their members.

## 2. It is Agreed:

The parties agreed to:

- 2.1 Exchange information and publications relevant to the development and profession of project management in Hong Kong and Singapore, and meet any reasonable requests for information that demonstrates how project management is developing in the respective countries.
- 2.2 Each party will nominate a representative to act as the liaison in relation to Clause 2.1 above.
- 2.3 Work together to raise the profile and recognition of project management in each country.
- 2.4 Recognise the categories of membership of the other party so that a person can join both organisations at the same level if they have met the entry criteria

established by the first organisation, subject to prior agreement of the criteria for each level of membership.

- 2.5 Waive assessment in accepting membership application by other party for the equivalent grade of "member" from the cooperative parties, subject to the fulfillment of the requirements as stipulated in the Clause 2.4.
- 2.6 Consult regularly in relation to the established criteria for membership per Clause 2.4 above and inform each other of changes to criteria.
- 2.7 Membership rates will be offered to members of both parties wishing to attend seminars, symposia, conferences held exclusively by the other party, upon demonstration of proof of membership.
- 2.8 Agree to recognise providers of project management services which have been endorsed by the other party.
- 2.9 Promote this agreement on their respective websites including a link from each website to the other party's website.

## 3. Term

This agreement will be effective commencing from the date the last signature is affixed. A review of the progress of this agreement will take place from time to time.

### 4. Termination

Either party may terminate this agreement by giving at least three months written notice to the other party.

# 5. Entire Agreement

This agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties.

### 6. Alteration

This agreement (including any schedules) may only be altered in writing signed by each party.
